

### Ratios - 3 Educators

Each of our preschool classrooms exceed ratio expectations by operating with 3 educators. This results in improved child outcomes by increasing safety, individual interaction, and opportunities for individual educational instruction.

Our programs provide a minimum of 150 annual hours of professional development for our staff, greatly exceeding all regulatory requirements. This level of investment mirrors how much we value our staff and are dedicated to their growth and fulfillment as professionals and individuals.

### Natural spaces

Homelike settings lower cortisol levels in children, affecting their cognitive development, behavior, and ability to learn. Each of our sites boast calm color schemes, soft lighting, comfortable furniture, and safe spaces where children feel at home.



# Open-ended materials

Providing children with open-ended materials rather than adult-conceived projects encourages imagination, creativity, and problem-solving skills. This approach creates play that is rich and complex, and allows children the right to pursue their own individual interests through play.
