Classroom Walkthroughs: A Message from our Curriculum Directors

We have been excited to visit classrooms during the last few weeks and appreciate the warm welcome from teachers and students. Walkthroughs are an ongoing process to

support continuous school improvement strategies in each building. We recognize that what is seen represents a "slice of time" in the classroom. We understand that the time we walk through may be during a transition, right before a field trip, or ten minutes after a brilliant class discussion. Data from these visits highlight work that buildings are engaged in, effective strategies that impact student learning, and provide feedback about our professional development practices. It is our hope that this process develops a professional culture of learning for all of us.

Next steps will include focused data talks during BLT meetings, staff PLC meetings and district principal meetings. This reflection on instructional strategies will guide us as we make adjustments to classroom practice that improves student achievement.

We are in this journey together for our students. Increasing rigor, engagement and achievement is "Mission Possible!"
