Year One

Students who enter the EMT program MUST have taken Anatomy and Physiology prior to enrolling. Students may also enroll as a second year Fire Science or Health Science student.

Year Two: EMT

Year two focuses on emergency medical services required of firefighters and other first responders. National Registry EMT certification is accepted by most states, preparing students for jobs immediately upon graduation. The program also offers students certification in CPR, PHTLS (Pre-hospital trauma life support), FEMA, and HAZMAT.
