

Everyone Deserves Health Insurance

You or your child may qualify for one of the state's health coverage plans or MDwise Marketplace, created and offered under the Affordable Care Act.

- » **The Hoosier Healthwise** program is for children under the age of 19 living in a low-income household.
- » **The Hoosier Care Connect** program is a coordinated care program for members age 65 and over; or with blindness or a disability who are residing in the community and are not eligible for Medicare. This program also includes children who are wards of the court, foster children and children receiving adoption assistance.
- » **MDwise Marketplace** offers health coverage for individuals and families in need of affordable health insurance. Anyone can apply, regardless of health status or pre-existing conditions.
- » **The Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP)** serves uninsured Hoosiers between the ages of 19–64 who are not eligible for Medicaid or Medicare.

To apply for Hoosier Healthwise, HIP or Hoosier Care Connect: Apply at your local enrollment center. To get a list of enrollment centers where you can apply in person, go to in.gov/fssa/dfr/2999.htm.
