Partners in Prevention

Last month, the Healthcare Foundation of La Porte awarded 11 LaPorte County schools/districts (including MCAS) grant funding for the Partners in Prevention initiative. The 3-year initiative provides our district with evidence-based curricula to help develop, identify, implement and sustain substance-use prevention programs. The programs foster positive relationships and social competencies, address addictive behavior, bullying, and violence, all while increasing school attendance, self-esteem and more. Implementation is beginning this fall in grades 4 & 5 with the Second Steps program; Botvin will be used in Grades 7 & 8.

During year two, Grades 2, 3, and 6 will be added and K, 1, and high school will be implemented during year three. Ray Silvas is coordinating this important initiative for our district.
